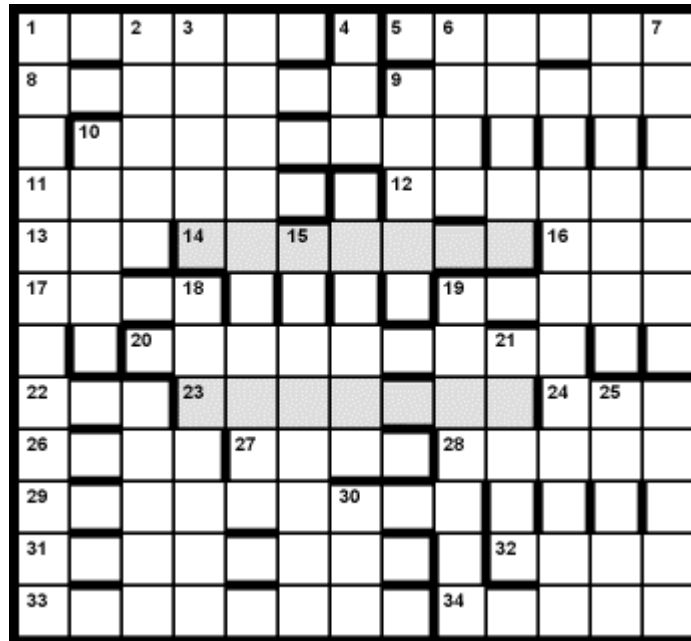


The phrase 14A 23A explains the other ten unclued entries.
