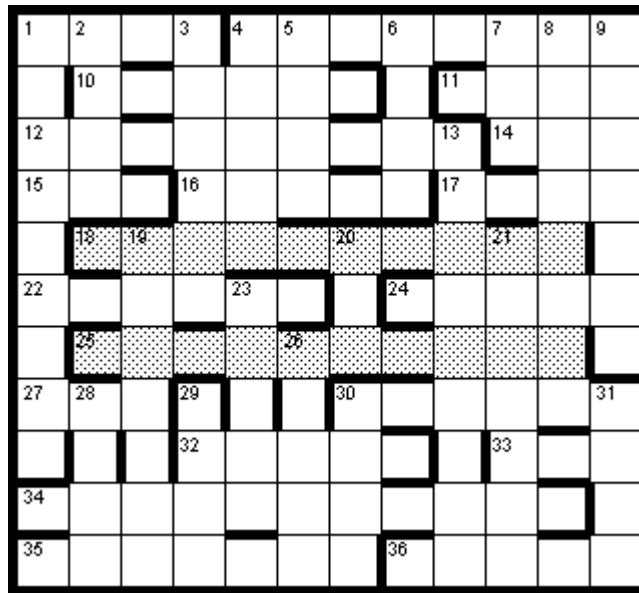


Eight answers become new words before entry, as indicated by 18A 25A.
